

PHHS Quarantine Expectations

Quarantined students should remain at home and avoid contact with people outside their households. If a student is quarantined they are expected to complete work on a daily basis and to be in communication with their teachers.

1 Attendance

Students that are quarantined **DO NOT** need to worry about taking their own attendance using the Google Form that would be used for Remote Learning. Mrs. Huss will mark students with a "quarantined absence" in Powerschool. If a student becomes ill, please call the school as soon as possible.

3 Assignments & Classwork

Students are expected to access their lessons and assignments via Google Classroom or email unless otherwise directed. Parents will receive a phone call from the school if there is material to pick up for their student. If a student has a question about submitting their work they should communicate with the teacher. Students will be responsible for submitting all assigned work by deadlines established by their teachers or upon their return to school.

Exceptions may be made by the teacher if a student has been communicating frequently with the teacher regarding their need for additional help.

Quizzes, tests, and other materials that are not able to be done from home are expected to be completed within a timely manner after the student has returned from quarantine.

2 Communication

Students are expected to communicate with their teachers. All teachers have shared with their students what the expectations are for their class if they are quarantined. If a student or parent has a question please reach out to the teacher via email or Google Classroom.
