## **MINUTES**

The Prairie Heights Community Schools Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, May 15, 2023 at 6:00 pm. The meeting was held in the administration office. Jeremy Swander, high school principal, led a discussion on graduation stoles and cords. He explained that in the past, we've allowed a stole for the Prairie Heights top 10, National Honor Society, and Military. We have allowed cords for Theater and FFA. We are now receiving requests for cords or stoles that represent cultures or clubs. Following conversation with the Board, Mr. Swander stated that he would follow past practice for the 2022-2023 graduation. The Board requested that Mr. Swander and Mr. Reed develop a policy for future years.

The Board heard building updates from the administrators and transportation updates from Officer Wisel.

Mr. Reed discussed that we would be adding an additional third grade position and a special education position at the elementary due to class sizes. Mr. Reed also stated that the middle school special education position that was never filled this school year would be posted again for next year.

Brook German, Board President, announced that she is moving out of the district and will be resigning in June.
