MINUTES

The Prairie Heights Community Schools Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, August 21, 2023 at 6:00 pm. The meeting was held in the administration office. - Heather Culler moved to approve the Resolution Authorizing Litigation Against Social Media Companies. Aaron Pfafman seconded the motion and approval was 5-0.
- Mike Howe moved to accept the 2023-2024 Food Service Contracts as presented by the Northern Indiana Educational Service Center. Jesslyn Senecal seconded the motion and approval was 5-0.
- Mike Howe moved to approve the advertisement of the 2024 budget. Heather Culler seconded the motion and approval was 5-0.
- Jesslyn Senecal moved to approve the first reading of ISBA policies. Aaron Pfafman seconded the motion and approval was 5-0.
- Mike Howe moved to suspend the rules to allow for the reading of ISBA policies for a second time. Heather Culler seconded the motion and approval was 5-0.

- Mike Howe moved to approve the recommendation to approve the condenser and coil replacement for the high school auxiliary gym at a cost of \$71,810.00 Heather Culler seconded the motion and approval was 5-0.

During the public comments, Atta "Tatsy" Hayes and Monica Rowe requested that the Turkey Creek Rangers plaque that is on display in the middle school be loaned out and displayed in South Milford at the old Farmers State Bank building. The Board agreed to this for a time period of one year and then will revisit. Tatsy or Monica will contact Mr. Reed when they are ready for it.

Building Principals gave updates on the start of the school year.

Officer Wisel provided updates on transportation and Dustin Holden gave a recap of the summer projects that were completed.

Mr. Reed informed the Board that the NEISEC CHOICE open house is September 14 from 1:00-4:00.

Mr. Reed provided information on the 2023 IREAD results and information on student enrollment for vocational classes.
